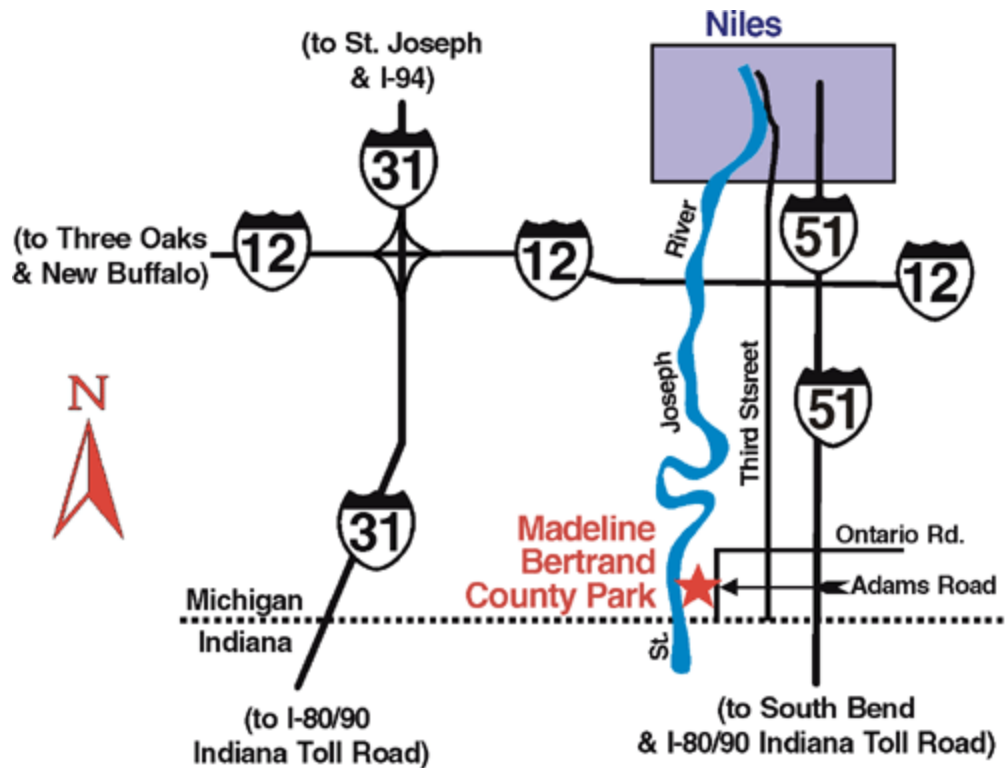

Take US933 North (31North) to flashing light at St. Line Road (right before you cross into Michigan). Turn Left on State Line and go down to stop sign, cross 3rd street and follow State Line around until it curves to the right and turns into Adams. Park entrance is first road on the left hand side.
