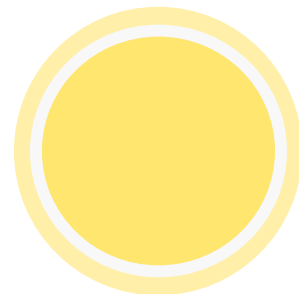
- ◆ Sociology reveals the **social factors** impacting human well-being.
