social class

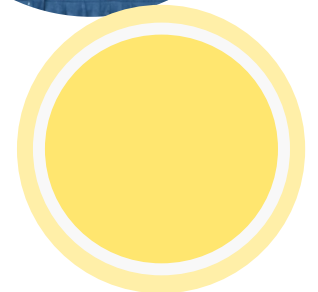
- ◆ Sociology enhances students' understanding of how the larger social environments in which people are embedded, influences perceptions and actions.
